'Business analysis is the practice of enabling change in an enterprise by defining needs and recommending solutions that deliver value to stakeholders.' Def: BABOK Guide



Business Analist

'Business analysts are responsible for discovering, synthesizing, and analyzing information from a variety of sources within an enterprise, including tools, processes, documentation, and stakeholders. The business analyst is responsible for eliciting the actual needs of stakeholders—which frequently involves investigating and clarifying their expressed desires—in order to determine underlying issues and causes.'

'Business analysts play a role in aligning the designed and delivered solutions with the needs of stakeholders. The activities that business analysts perform include:


- understanding enterprise problems and goals

- facilitating stakeholder collaboration'






